Writers Tears comes from Walsh Whiskey Distillery. Now known as Royal Oak distillery located in Bagenalstown County Carlow Ireland. Walsh whiskey started in 1999 by husband and wife Bernard and Rosemary Walsh. I think my favorite thing about this whiskey (other than how delicious it is obviously) is that it is named after some of Irelands famous writers

like James Joyce, Oscar Wilde, Bram Stoker, William Butler Yeats. It is said that after they would drink so much Irish whiskey that when they cried, their tears were made of whiskey.
