Same for the Pot still, very drinkable as a stand-alone dram, but also very good for making delicious cocktail!



Unfortunately, these are the only two that we are offered in the great state of Oregon. If that sounds a little sassy, it was meant to be. When I travel to Washington DC, I love to go to the Jack Rose dining saloon. They have probably around 30-40+ different Willett Rye's to choose from. So, the fact we only get two is kind of depressing. But however, I am very glad to at least get these.

Willett has been around since 1936, started right outside of Bardstown Kentucky! They are and have been very well respected in the whiskey world and produce many other very fine expressions.

The company was founded as the Willett Distilling Company in 1936. The company has remained under family ownership and operation at the same location since it was created.

John David Willett was born in 1841 as the master distiller for the Moore, Willett & Frenke Distillery, which he had formed with his brother-in-law Thomas S. Moore of Bardstown, and Mr. Frenke of Louisville.

In 1876, Willett fell ill and sold his interest in the company. He would recover and live another 38 years, passing in 1914.
