This month we are featuring 1792 Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey. This Barton 1792 Distillery was established in 1879 and resides in Bardstown, Kentucky. It sits on nearly 200 acres and is the oldest operating distillery in Bardstown.

The name 1792 is the year Kentucky became a state. It was originally known as “Ridgewood Reserve 1792”, then after some lawsuits and became just 1792. The current master distiller is Ross Cornelissen. Cornelissen left MGP to come and work for Sazerac and 1792 just recently in 2022. The previous master distiller was Danny Kahn who left in 2021.
