

This month of June 2026 we're featuring one of bourbon's most legendary names: **Weller Bourbon**.

Known as *The Original Wheated Bourbon*, Weller traces its roots back to the 1800s when William Larue Weller pioneered the use of wheat instead of rye in the mash bill, creating a smoother, softer bourbon profile that would eventually become one of the most influential recipes in American whiskey.

Today, Weller is produced at Buffalo Trace Distillery in Frankfort, Kentucky, and has become one of the most sought-after bourbon brands in the world. Its connection to the famed Pappy Van Winkle line has only increased its popularity, making many expressions difficult to find at retail, let alone on a back bar.

A Few Weller Facts

- William Larue Weller began selling bourbon in Louisville in the mid-1800s and is credited with popularizing wheated bourbon.
- Weller's wheated mash bill replaces rye with wheat, resulting in a softer and sweeter flavor profile.
- Buffalo Trace Distillery, where Weller is produced today, is one of the oldest continuously operating distilleries in America.
- William Larue Weller is released only once per year and is considered one of the most collectible bourbons in the world.
