Whisk(e)y of the month for February, WhistlePig!!!



This whiskey comes from Shoreham Vermont. Founded in 2007 and launched in 2010, releasing its first whiskey in 2015, a wonderful, 10yr rye. It was on this day that the rye category got a big new addition. Entrepreneur and founder Raj Bhakta purchased the land where he built the distillery and WhistlePig was born. Dave Pickerell was the original distiller. Dave was considered one of the most influential distillers in regard to “craft” distilling. He cut his thread at Makers Mark and even founded his own Whiskey consulting

firm that helped over 100 distilleries grow. I think one kinda cool thing he did was working with the band Metallica consulting to release a whiskey called “Blackened”. Kind of gimmicky but pretty cool and the whiskey is actually pretty good. But I digress as this month is about WhistlePig. The Pint Pot offers a wide variety of expressions from WhistlePig. The pub just got in one of their newest Limited Releases that they did with Liquid Death. Very excited to try it.



The pub has Expressions from WhistlePig ranging from \$9 to \$80. Many of these are very hard to find bottles and ones that I would guess most of you have not tried yet. I highly encourage you to take advantage of this month. Your discount for this month is -\$4 a dram for all their expressions EXCEPT the Boss Hog's or the 18yr bottles. Your discount is -\$10 a dram. No limit on how many you can try, again this discount only applies to “your” drams, not ones you buy for other people. In addition, last month's whisk(e)y of the month is still available to you for the month as well.
