

Nikka Whisky is our featured whiskey for October. The original owner / distiller named Masataka Taketsuru is celebrated as the most influential whisky distillers to ever exist in Japan.

He was sent to Scotland around 1918 to study scotch, distilling and organic chemistry at The University of Glasgow under a professor named T.S Patterson.

Taketsuru then went on to learn all about malt whisky production and spent his beginning years at Longmorn Distillery in Strathspey, then went to Hazelburn Distillery in Campbeltown.

That distillery was then owned by Springbank. He was only there for about 6 months before returning to Japan. When he returned to Japan he went on to work for a company that would eventually become “Suntory”. He helped establish them as a major brand, then he broke away and started Nikka distillery in 1934 in Yoichi Hokkaido Japan.
