

# BIRTHDAY PARTY FAQs

## HOW MANY ARE ALLOWED TO SKATE WITH EACH PACKAGE?

- Each package is the same in terms of number of individuals who are able to skate. If you choose the 1 hour of private ice option, you can have up to 50 skaters. If you choose the 2 hours of public skating option, you will receive 25 vouchers for the public skate on the date of your event. Each voucher includes skate rental and admission.
- For the public skate options, you may pay for additional skaters at our normal public skate rate.
- For the 1 hour of private skating, we limit it to 50 skaters to ensure we have enough skates for all parties and other events that may be happening at the same time. If the majority of your party has their own skates, we can certainly accommodate more than 50 people on the ice for your private skating event.

## CAN ADULTS SKATE OR IS THIS JUST FOR THE CHILDREN/KIDS?

- Yes, adults are able to skate. It is completely up to you who uses the vouchers and who skates.

## CAN WE ADD ADDITIONAL FOOD OPTIONS TO THE PACKAGES OR MAKE SUBSTITUTIONS?

- Yes, we want to make sure you have what you want/need for your party. If the packages do not suit your needs we are willing to work with you to make sure your event is a memorable one.
- Individuals in your party may also order from the restaurant's everyday menu.

## CAN WE HAVE A NET ON THE ICE WITH HOCKEY STICKS AND PUCKS?

- This is an option during the private ice time but not an option for public skating. If you chose to have a hockey net, sticks and pucks on the ice during your event, ALL individuals on the ice MUST have on a helmet. We do not provide sticks, pucks or helmets.

## DO YOU HAVE SKATING AIDS/TRAINERS AVAILABLE FOR THOSE WHO ARE LEARNING TO SKATE?

- Yes, we have skating trainers readily available at no additional cost. For Public Skate: they are available at first come, first serve



The Private Ice option is very limited between November and February, we will try to accommodate the best we can, but the ice schedule fills up quickly. Public Skate sessions on the weekends are VERY busy between Thanksgiving weekend and the end of February. If the guest chooses to attend Public Skate, they will need to come get their skates before the start of the session, we cannot hold skates.
