Message from the Chairman

A couple of months ago I wrote to you about the need to raise the membership dues. As of now, we may need to drop 107 members who have not paid their dues this year. With members moving, financial issues and deaths, this is totally understandable. We have also added about 30 new members to the club. Even with the increased dues, we are still having difficulties making ends meet. Our building is over 70 years old and is showing its age. We had to spend over \$80,000 fixing plumbing, kitchen repairs and equipment replacement in the past couple of months. As you have heard on the news, employment costs have gone up. Your own home food costs have gone up along with increases in your gas and electricity costs. Add to this an increase in our insurance premiums. When you look back before the pandemic, we had about \$400,000 in reserve for the club. Since then, with the closure of the club during the pandemic, increased operating costs, reduced number of dinners because of the difficulties in getting cooks and waiters, our reserve has diminished to about \$100,000 and is dropping each month.

Besides asking you to book your reservations for club events, what it comes down to is this, keeping the costs of our birthday dinners and family dinners as low as they have been is no longer a possibility. I have surveyed the attendees at two of our birthday dinners in May. We will also send out a four question survey to each of you. I have kept it to four questions hoping that you will spend a minute to give us your thoughts (PLEASE RESPOND TO THE SURVEY!) I have also assembled a group of board members and officers to look into a long range financial plan for the club, so we can determine our next financial steps. As a first step starting this month the Board has voted to increase the cost of our dinners to \$33 for members and \$38 for guests. Special events costs are determined separately.

The Fratangelo family have had a lasting influence on the growth of the club. Ray, Pat and currently Vince, have spent hours and hours overseeing and getting involved with the growth and beautification of the club. Ray has been honored for generous and extraordinary commitment of time, support and leadership to the Colombo Club. His contributions include: President from 1984 to 1985, bartender, cook, Board of Director, First Vice President, 2nd Vice President, 3rd Vice President, Club Manager, frequent participant in club golf events and every other club event, House Committee Chair for 10 years, Gold Card member, electrical worker around the club, volunteer at club picnics and a frequent work party



participant.
Ray dedicated time every day to projects that included wiring the Ed Basso Room, spearheading the renovation


of the ballroom, club room, dining room and kitchen. Pat served as a president of the women's Auxiliary, chaired many fund raising events and is the only woman honored on the club's Wall of Honor. Vince spent many hours in his early life working with his dad at the club on the club wiring and is currently the club's First Vice President after serving on the club Board. Vince is overseeing the security system upgrades for the club building.

The Penna family have been very instrumental in the growth and success of the club. John Penna's contributions include: Club President 1960-1961, Cook, Board member, Historian, Member of the first Children's Christmas Committee, work party participant, Chairman of the Board of Directors for 10 years, Christmas setup volunteer, helped with the incentive program well into his 90's, chair and participant in the golf events. His motion at an Assembly Meeting led to the creation of the "Military Service Wall of Honor." He represented the club as a guest of Frank Sinatra in Tahoe and picked up Rocky Marciano at the airport for a club event. A plaque with his picture hangs in the Isabella Room for all of his efforts to collect and save Club memorabilia. A gold chair in the dining room commemorates the fact that John was a fixture most all club events. Before becoming club president (1990-1991) Jim Penna was Chairman of the Board for 7 years. Jim has many family ties to the foundations of the Colombo Club. He is a third generation Colombo Club member. Jim's grandfather S. Orio and his uncle John Orio and his great uncle Ottavino Cavallo were all charter members of the Club. Jim's other grandfather, Mike Roggero, was the club's

first head cook for many years. Jim's grandmother, Maria Roggero, was one of the founders of the Colombo Club Women's Auxiliary. After serving as president, Jim has been providing the
