Lou Celia served the club as the Chairman of the Board and was elected to the Board for three separate

terms. He is remembered for always being a very active member, volunteering on work parties and telling jokes at club lunches. He is seen here at a club anniversary dinner with his wife. Lou is also responsible for recognized for making a tumbler "squirrel cage" for the birthday dinner raffles. In June 1980, 20 members volunteered to do extensive cleaning and painting of the club, which took place under the direction of Lou Celia and Ed Basso. It was said that if the members continued to upgrade the kitchen, "Chef George Mossino would be forced to wear a tie while cooking." Dominic stated, "I can personally attest to the fact that Lou and Ed were the driving forces as I am wearing lash marks on my back as a result of Lou's expertise with the whip.

Billy Castell's contributions to the club include: serving as President of the club 1998-1999, 1st vice president, 2nd vice president, 3rd vice president, chair of the club's election committee, procured baseball memorabilia from the Oakland A's and handed them out at father/son dinner nights, represented the club in interclub bocce tournaments, gold card member, organized the club's annual trip to the A's vs Giants baseball game at the Oakland Coliseum, Board of Director for many years and volunteer at many Colombo Club events. He is a club gold card member. Billy

is truly a sports aficionado. His baseball career started early in his life. In 1949 in New York when he was 18 years old, he met baseball legend Joe DiMaggio. Recently, he was a member of the Colombo Club bocce team that won the 2023 all Italian Clubs Bocce Tournament. Billy's



continued contributions to the club are so important to the growth of the club.

The last featured member of the club who has been a vital part of the growth of the Colombo is Joe Guerrero. Joe recalls that in the early 1950s, when he was out of work during a butchers' strike, he was given the job of setting up chairs and tables in the club dining room for 5 cents a chair.

He also said that no matter how early he got to the club to do this, the job had already been done by some older members who were already there early in the morning to play cards. They told him that he could still get the pay anyway because he needed the money.



Joe still volunteers in the kitchen and setting tables (only he does not get paid the 5 cents a chair anymore). Joe's other contributions include: Colombo Club President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Board of Director, Catering Manager, Colombo Club Work Day Volunteer, Volunteer tubala chair at the Italian Clubs' Annual Picnic, Head Table Setter, Volunteer Cook for Assembly Dinners,
