Our Cultural Heritage

Colombo Club Events in December throughout the Years

In December, 1922, the total financial assets of the club were \$157.

On December 28, 1937, the club passed a resolution to permit the newly formed women's auxiliary use of the club for \$2.50 to conduct their monthly sessions. They were charged \$7.50 for use of the kitchen.

Due to the large number of requests, banquet tickets for the grand opening of the club were limited to two per member at \$4 each. The grand opening of the club on Claremont Avenue was held on December 16, 1951.



In December 1951, the last minutes of the Board meetings written in Italian were recorded. Starting in 1951, the minutes for the Board meetings and club applications were written in English..

The first Children's Christmas Party was in December, 1952. It was proposed in a Board meeting by Frank Dingman and Al DeBenedetti, who became chairs of the first Children's Christmas party, to hold the event the week before Christmas every year. John Penna, Louie Pandolfo, John Dame and John Gai were the committee that organized the event. George Mossino was the assistant kitchen chef and the first Santa Claus. He played that role

every Christmas from 1951 to 1991. The boy in the photo is Jim Penna (club president 1990-1991).



In the 1950s, members could buy Schlitz beer for \$3 and Falstaff for \$3.50 by the case at the club. The practice was stopped in December 1953. It was hurting local club members who sold beer commercially.

The bar account for December 1953 showed a loss, which Al DeBenedetti attributed to "inexperienced help and the season of the year when bartenders were inclined to be liberal with over pouring."

After a year of preparation and in a cost cutting move, in December 2007, the club started to publish its newsletter online for members who signed up for it.

In December 2007, the annual Children's Christmas Party was dedicated to Roger Verducci, Sr., who for years was one of the driving forces behind this annual event. In December 2016, the Christmas party was dedicated to Pat Fratangelo, an Auxiliary past president, who worked every year to help make the Christmas party a success.

One of the first events to be reinstated after the Covid pandemic was the Colombo Club Anniversary Dinner on December 4, 2021.


