At the Auxiliary meeting on October 15th, we will be introducing the candidates for the election in November.





#### Colombo Club Online Ticket Sales and FAQs

#### Rationale for the change

This fall, the Club will transition to taking most reservations and payments for events online. No worries if you are not proficient in placing online orders. We will help anyone trying to make online payments. If this doesn't work for you, then we will ask you to prepay for future events when you are at the Club or send in a payment. It's important that we receive your payment prior to the event reservation cutoff date, or before the event is sold out

#### Why are we changing the reservation process?

The reasons for this change include:

- Members have requested that we simplify the reservation process and also adopt technology that makes it easier to make reservations
- Eliminating no shows from members that make reservations, but then they or their guests do not attend ("No-Shows") which impact the Club negatively both financially as well as impacting our efficiency
- Responding to members who prefer to pay with a credit card online
- Reducing the administrative burden involved in managing reservations:
  - o managing messages on our phone system
  - o listening to phone messages
  - o eliminating manually creating a reservation list
  - o eliminating mistakes due to inaudible phone messages
  - o providing receipts via email and acts as a confirmation of payment, and more.

#### How to make a reservation:

- 1. Go to the website the colomboclub.com
- 2. Click on the "calendar of events" tab
- 3. Find the event you want to purchase tickets for, click on it
- 4. Add your ticket first, then click on "add to cart". You can add more tickets after that
- 5. Check out and pay
- 6. You will receive an email confirmation of your order

#### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

- I don't have a credit card.
- We accept debit cards as well
- Can I still call the Club and make a reservation?
- Yes, for September and October. After that, you can leave a message at the Club and someone will call you to assist with your online purchase.

- Why is the Club changing to online reservations?
- Each event we have a number of "No-Show" reservations. This costs the Club money as we buy food/supplies for the number of reservations our members make via our phone reservation system. Online reservations ensure that the Club is paid for all reservations made. Other private clubs have successfully used this method for years
- What if I'm not comfortable using online technology? Am I not able to attend an event?
- Absolutely not! We value you as a member and will continue to support all members attending any event that they choose to attend. The payment method that you choose will not impact your ability to make a reservation, but it will change some. You will need to prepay for the event so that the Club receives your payment before the cutoff date or before the event is sold out. So if you see an event that is important to you, please act immediately to get your reservation to the Club.
- What if I can't make an online reservation?
- o The Club benefits when you make your reservations online. This lowers our cost and also protects all members from having to pay for "no-shows". If you cannot make an online reservation for an event, call our reservation hot line at (510) 653-9716 and leave a message.
- When I make an online reservation, is the information that I provide secure?
  Yes. The Club does not store any of your personal information (name, credit card #, etc.) and our site uses the latest, industry-standard payment security.
- What do I do if I try, but for some reason I am unable to complete an online reservation?
  We want to ensure that if you want to attend an event you are able to pay for and attend that event. If you have an issue when making an online reservation, please contact us via our website (https://www.thecolomboclub.com/contact/) and we will reach out to you to troubleshoot the issue or manage payment for the event.
- What if I need to cancel my reservation, after I paid for my tickets?
  Just as before, tickets are fully refundable up to the Sunday before the event (if it's a Birthday Dnner). We will provide cancellation dates for all events. Contact us via our website and ask for a refund.
