Chardonnay, Domaine Pernot-Belicard Bourgogne Côte d'Or, Burgundy, FR 2022 26

Pernot-Belicard is a relatively new, up and coming rock star in Burgundy. Run by Phillipe Pernot, scion and grandson of Paul Pernot (a legendary producer in Puligny-Montrachet), he married into the Belicard family who have enviable holdings in multiple villages including Puligny and Meursault. This Domaine's star is on the rise and offers tremendous value...for now. Luscious; with mandarin orange, white peach and white flowers with fine grained, chalky minerality.

Pinot Noir, Domaine Joseph Roty Marsannay AOP, Côte de Nuits, Burgundy, FR 2021 35

Iconoclast. Eccentric. Legend. All names used to describe this singular producer from the Côte de Nuits in Burgundy. Boasting some of the oldest vines in Burgundy, wines from this Domaine are highly sought after by critics and collectors alike. 2021 was a classic, cooler, more restrained vintage producing wines of more elegance, structure and acidity. Medium to full bodied with notes of black cherries and plums, licorice and spice.

Bordeaux Blend, Château Haut-Segottes St. Emilion Grand Cru AOP, Bordeaux, FR 2021 31

Now on its fourth generation, this tiny 9ha property produces terroir driven, artisan wines of incredible complexity from a superior site in St. Emilion located only a few hundred meters from the venerable Cheval Blanc. 60% Cabernet Franc with 40% Merlot, all organically farmed, hand harvested, aged predominantly in neutral oak, this is a wine for the true Bordeaux enthusiast. Black cherry and red plum dance with cinnamon, dried violets, cedar, and a hint of truffle.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Grgich Hills Estate Napa Valley AVA, CA 2020 31

First vaulted to fame by the famous "Judgment of Paris" of 1976 (which put Napa Valley on the map), Mike Grgich has been synonymous with world class Napa wine for over 45 years. Since 1977, Grgich Hills has been an icon for producing benchmark Napa wines of grace and finesse. Organically farmed and solar powered since 2006, these wines are a testament to sustainable practices and clean farming. This Cabernet Sauvignon is balanced and elegant, with notions of cassis and blackberry, savory herb, and creamy tannins.

Tempranillo Blend, R. Lopez de Heredia, "Viña Bosconia" Rioja DOCa, Spain 2013 33

Still owned by the family who founded it over 130 years ago, R. Lopez de Heredia exemplifies what traditional Rioja is all about. Founded in 1877 as one of the three original Bodegas in Rioja, wines from Lopez de Heredia are some of the most age worthy and coveted on the planet. Sourced exclusively from family-owned vineyards, their Reserva, single vineyard "Bosconia" is earthy and juicy, yet elegant and refined. Displaying notes of sweet and sour cherry, pomegranate, fall leaves and wild mushrooms while finishing with dried hibiscus and lip-smacking acidity.

366	Champagne Colin, Blanc de Blancs (100% Chardonnay)	Grand Cru, Champagne AOP	2011	150
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From seventh generation grower/producer Champagne Colin comes this ravishingly elegant Grand Cru champagne made from 100% Chardonnay. Sourced from 10 hectares of vineyards located in the Grand Cru villages of Cramant and Oiry in the prestigious region of the Côte de Blancs, this wine displays that rare duality of richness meets precision that only comes from meticulous winemaking and an excellent vintage. Long and graceful, with an opulent mousse, this wine offers notes of citrus and orchard fruit, fresh pastries, and marzipan, while finishing with a dazzling chalk driven minerality. We dare you to find a better Grand Cru “farmer fizz” champagne at this price!

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Winemaker Travis Allen, a San Diego native, met his wife Mario at SDSU, caught the wine bug and decided to forgo his career as a nurse-anesthetist and focus on producing unique, small production wines from top sites in Washington state. This Syrah is stunning, redolent of cool blue fruit, tar, spice and ash. Unapologetically New-World while still paying homage to its Old-World roots. If you haven't heard of these wines, consider yourselves warned...this is Washington's next big thing.

Linear and sleek, with almost rapier-like precision, this wine from Sauvignon Blanc's native home of Sancerre bursts at the seams with textbook notes of citrus, green herbs, crisp acidity and a glittering minerality that dances on the palate. Pair with salads, crudos, shellfish and/or a bright sunny day!

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Hyde de Villaine is a venture between two of wine's royal families: the Hyde Family of Napa Valley (theirs is arguably the best vineyard in Carneros) and the de Villaine Family of the inimitable and legendary Domaine de la Romanée Conti in Burgundy (the most coveted wines in the world). This, still under the radar venture, may quite possibly be the most seismic partnership since Baron de Rothschild and Robert Mondavi of Opus One. The "Ygnacia" Pinot Noir comes from a 2.5-acre plot planted specifically for this wine by the Hyde Family. Notes of pomegranate, raspberry, crushed rose petal mingle with notions of smoke and anise. Hedonistic and sexy, this wine is billowing red satin on the palate.

Sommelier Suggestions

Kobayashi Winery...Washington Wine with San Diego Roots

Kobayashi Winery out of Washington State, owned and operated by Travis and Mario Allen, is making some of the most limited, innovative and flat-out sensational wines in the country. Winemaker **Travis Allen, a San Diego native**, caught the wine bug and decided to forgo his career as a nurse-anesthetist, instead focusing on producing unique, small production wines from top sites in Washington. The 2022 Viognier stopped me dead in my tracks and is simply the best New World Viognier I have ever tasted. The Syrah is stunning as well, redolent of cool blue fruit, tar, spice and ash. These are electric, cerebral wines best sipped slowly over time and with a great meal. If you haven't heard of Kobayashi, consider yourselves warned...this is Washington's next big thing.

Glossary of Terms

General Wine Quality Levels

AOP (France) - Appellation d'Origine Protégée – Protected Appellation of Origin - This is a specified area with defined boundaries and specific rules for growing and making wine.

DO (Spain) - Denominación Origen - This is a specified area with defined boundaries and specific rules for growing and making wine.

DOQ/DOCa (Spain) - Denominación Origen Calificada - This is a specified area with defined boundaries and specific rules for growing and making wine that has achieved the highest reputation for quality in Spain.

DOP (Portugal) - Denominação de Origem Protegida - This is a specified area with defined boundaries and specific rules for growing and making wine.

AVA (USA) - American Viticultural Area - This is an area with defined boundaries that has a similar influence on wine growing as it applies to its terroir / geology and climate. There are no rules for what growers may, or may not, grow.

County Appellations (USA) - These are political boundaries which may, or many not, contain AVA.

France

Vielles Vignes - Old Vine - This term has no legal definition, but producers will use it to designate bottlings from the older & more established vines on their property. I have heard a general rule of thumb: "If the vines are older than the wine-grower, then they can call it Vieilles Vignes!"

Regional (quality level) - This is a geographical quality level that applies mainly to the wines of Burgundy. For this level a producer can use fruit from anywhere in the region. They are typically very easy to drink young and are very reasonable in price.

Village (quality level) - This is a geographical quality level that applies mainly to the wines of Burgundy. These wines must be grown within the geographical boundaries of the specified village on the label only. Some villages have earned higher esteem and demand than others. They are priced according to both this reputation and this demand

Lieu-Dit - Named place - A term typically used in Burgundy. A lieu-dit (pronounced: LOU-dee) is a vineyard site that carries a name that has been historically associated with it. That site, however, has not been classified as a 1er Cru, nor Grand Cru. It is simply a "named place" vineyard.

1er Cru (quality level) - This is a geographical quality level that applies mainly to the wines of Burgundy. Within villages there are specific vineyards with specific boundaries that have demonstrated over a long period of time that they are consistently producing wines of a higher quality and demand than their neighboring vineyards. Wines coming from these vineyards can have their name appended to the Village name and qualify for a Premier Cru (1er Cru) designation on the label.

Grand Cru (quality level) - This is a geographical quality level that applies mainly to the wines of Burgundy and Alsace. Within villages there are specific vineyards with specific boundaries that have demonstrated over a long period of time that they are consistently producing wines of the absolute highest quality possible. Beyond that of the 1er Cru vineyards. In this case, producers do not even put the name of the village on the label, only the name of the Grand Cru. These wines demand the highest prices in Burgundy and are the most sought after, prized, and hoarded by wine collectors.

Grand Cru Classé - This designation has been given mainly to the wines of Bordeaux and Cotes-de-Provence. Specific producers have shown the ability to produce a caliber of wine much higher than the vast majority of other producers in their region. Producer groups in these regions have designated (or classified) the best of the best and allowed them to use the term "Grand Cru Classe" on their labels. In the case of the Medoc region of Bordeaux they separated 61 producers into 5 different levels of "Grand Cru Classe."

United States

Reserve - Has no legal definition. Any producer can use this term for any reason...

Estate Bottled - A producer must own (or control through lease) 100% of the land used to grow the grapes used in a bottling. Additionally, all vineyards used must be located in the same AVA as the winery itself.

Glossary of Terms

Italy

Superiore - Typically refers to a richer wine than might normally come from the region. In the rules of production for the region it is usually expressed by having a higher minimum alcohol than the normal standard for the region. Amounts will vary from region to region.

Riserva - This is an aging requirement term. It almost always requires a longer aging process before the wine can be released for sale to the public. The length and type of aging (cask vs. bottle) will vary from region to region. For example, a wine labeled Barolo DOCG must be aged for 38 months (including 18 in cask) before it can be released; whereas a wine labeled Barolo Riserva must be aged for 62 months (including 18 in cask) before being released.

Spain

Crianza - This is the first level of aging designations in Spain. It typically designates 12 months total aging including 6 months in cask for whites & rosés; and 18 months total aging including 6 months in cask for reds. This is a generalized amount, some DO's & DOCA's may have their own individualized rules.

Reserva - This is the second level of aging designations in Spain. It typically designated 24 months total aging including 6 months in cask for whites & rosés; and 36 months total aging including 12 months in cask for reds. This is a generalized amount, some DO's & DOCA's may have their own individualized rules.

Gran Reserva - This is the highest level of aging designation in Spain. It typically designates 48 months total aging including 6 months in cask for whites & rosés; and 60 months total aging including 18 months in cask for reds. This is a generalized amount, some DO's & DOCA's may have their own individualized rules.

Germany

Pradikats - These are quality levels that are directly associated to the amount of sugar level in the grape when it is harvested. This correlates to the amount of potential alcohol and body the wine may have after fermentation.

Kabinett - The first of the "pradikats." Kabinett typically indicates a wine of a very delicate nature. One might expect find the slightest bit of residual sugar here; just a prickle of sweetness, not much more than that.

Spätlese - Probably the most widely encountered "pradikat." Spätlese wines have been harvested a bit late, their sugars have started to concentrate and there is a bit of botrytis (noble rot) on them. Expect these wines to have a good amount (but not dessert level yet) of residual sugar & sweetness but are still classified as table wines.

Auslese - Wines of this designation sit right on the edge of having enough sugar to be dessert wines. There has been a noticeable, but not extreme amount of water evaporation leaving the grapes raisin-like. They have a very noticeable amount of botrytis and residual sugar.

Beerenauslese (BA) - This is the first pradikat level that is squarely in the dessert wine category. They typically only come in 375ml & 500ml sized bottles. Climatic conditions need to be just right to make these wines correctly. They have been left on the vines much later than most, have a high amount of raisination, and show an elevated level of botrytis.

Eiswein - This is one of the rarest types of German & Austrian wines. The climatic conditions have to be just perfect. The grapes have to naturally freeze on the vine at the exact right time. The ice crystals in the water turn to ice, but the sugar and grape nectar do not. These wines are highly concentrated in sugar, and are incredibly sweet with a rich, syrupy texture that still manages to not appear cloying.

Trockenbeerenauslese (TBA) - A legendary wine in the world of dessert wines. Very little compares to TBA. The grapes are very shriveled and covered with botrytis. They are unctuously sweet with the viscosity of high-quality fresh maple syrup. These wines are powerful and precise at the same time.

Trocken - Dry. A wine with 9 grams per liter of residual sugar or less.

Gutwein - A wine made from within a specified large region. That region's name must be on the label.

Ortswein - A wine made from a specific village. The village name must appear on the label.

Erste Lage (First Growth) - A term synonymous with 1er Cru in Burgundy. These wines can be dry, off-dry, or sweet.

GG (Grosses Gewachs) - A term synonymous with Grand Cru in Burgundy. These wines must be trocken/dry.
