Main Restaurant

ONLY AVAILABLE WITH FULL BUYOUTS

Inspired by Japanese design, the main restaurant features clean lines, exposed brick, natural wood and a serene atmosphere. A large built-in bar serves as the focal point of the room. This space is used during full buyouts for cocktail hour and dancing.

Just beyond the main space, a large covered outdoor courtyard extends the celebration outdoors. Featuring two satellite bars, flexible cocktail seating, and cozy outdoor bungalows.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS A WEDDING COORDINATOR REQUIRED?

Yes, all couples are required to work with an approved coordinator or planner. This helps your day run smoothly and lets our team focus fully on food, bar and venue operations. A coordinator typically handles things like seating chart and place card set-up, managing vendor schedules, cueing important moments like ceremony processional, speeches and formal dances, and handling any last minute changes on the day.

IS A WEDDING TASTING INCLUDED?

Yes, a tasting is included and complimentary for the couple.

CAN WE BRING IN OUTSIDE DESSERT?

Yes, you're welcome to bring in your own dessert, whether that's a wedding cake or other fun treats. There's no additional fee for cutting, plating, or serving it.

IS THERE A WEDDING SUITE?

Yes, a private suite is available for bride, groom, and wedding party beginning 2 hours prior to invitation start time, stocked with beverages (wine, beer, soft drinks, water). This space is not suitable for getting ready so you should still plan to get ready offsite.

DO YOU PROVIDE LINENS?

We don't have linens in-house, though they're not required or necessary. If you like the look of linens, we're happy to coordinate a rental through a third-party vendor.

IS THE VENUE ADA ACCESSIBLE?

Yes, our entire venue including entrances, event spaces, restrooms, and outdoor areas is fully ADA accessible.

WHAT DOES THE OPERATION FEE COVER?

The operations fee covers all staffing. Gratuity is not expected nor required.

WHEN IS FINAL GUEST COUNT DUE?

30 days before the wedding.

ARE CANDLES ALLOWED?

Yes! We allow open flame in all our spaces.

IS THERE PARKING ONSITE?

We don't have onsite parking, but the closest lot is just two blocks away, underneath the William Vale Hotel. Most guests use rideshare, the subway, or walk from nearby hotels, valet is also an option if you'd like to arrange one.

DO YOU OFFER VENDOR MEALS?

Yes, vendors meals are \$35 each.

DO YOU OFFER KIDS MEALS?

Yes, kids ages 3-10 can receive a kids meal and soft drinks for \$75 each.
