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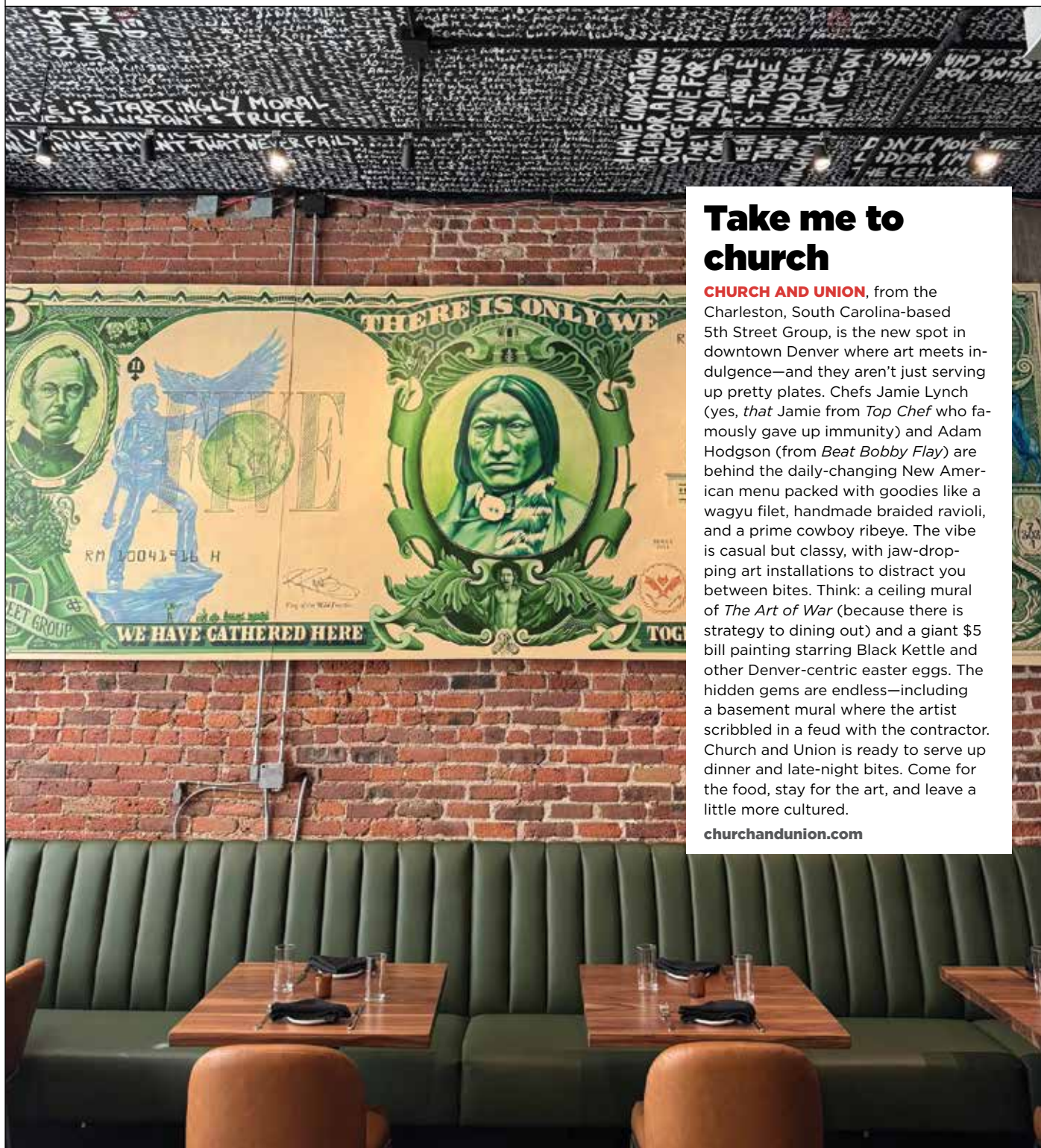

Take me to church

CHURCH AND UNION, from the Charleston, South Carolina-based 5th Street Group, is the new spot in downtown Denver where art meets indulgence—and they aren't just serving up pretty plates. Chefs Jamie Lynch (yes, *that* Jamie from *Top Chef* who famously gave up immunity) and Adam Hodgson (from *Beat Bobby Flay*) are behind the daily-changing New American menu packed with goodies like a wagyu filet, handmade braided ravioli, and a prime cowboy ribeye. The vibe is casual but classy, with jaw-dropping art installations to distract you between bites. Think: a ceiling mural of *The Art of War* (because there is strategy to dining out) and a giant \$5 bill painting starring Black Kettle and other Denver-centric easter eggs. The hidden gems are endless—including a basement mural where the artist scribbled in a feud with the contractor. Church and Union is ready to serve up dinner and late-night bites. Come for the food, stay for the art, and leave a little more cultured.
