Sommelier Selections

Champagne, in the northern pastoral plains of France, is home to some of the most dedicated grape growers in France. Created using the *methode champenoise* where a second fermentation takes place in bottle, a difference in grape, blend, vintage, or vineyard site can show a wide spectrum of wines. We think Champagne is refined enough for celebrations but shouldn't only be saved for special occasions! The following are three highlights of small grower producer Champagnes from a range of regions and styles.

0133 J. Lassalle 1er Cru Rosé Brut NV Champagne, France 160

Made by three generations of women winemakers, J. Lassalle's Rosé is a Pinot Noir dominant blend from the heart of the Montagne de Reims. The ladies of Lassalle use an ancient basket press to extract the most delicate juice, resulting in an elegant Champagne that drinks like strawberries and cream.

0101 Egly-Ouriet Grand Cru Extra Brut NV 262

Egly-Ouriet is one of the original Grower Champagnes Wines, long before "Grower Champagne" was even part of the conversation. This bottling is a selection of older-vine fruit, 70% Pinot Noir and 30% Chardonnay, from the Grand Cru villages of Ambonnay, Verzenay and Bouzy, aged for three years in bottle. This Champagne is super expressive with aromas and flavors of red berries, blood orange and toast.

**0124 Vincey Le Grand Jardin - Oger Grand Cru Blanc de
Blancs Brut 2015 326**

Le Grand Jardin is an opulent and rich expression of 100% Chardonnay from the Grand Cru vineyard site of Oger. Crafted by 8th Generation grower Quentin Vincey, this Champagne is fermented and aged in oak casks before bottling nearly five years after harvest.

The region's most famous vineyards are located in the heart of Burgundy, the *Côte d'Or* or *Golden Slope*, but you can find something for everyone on our list. The styles here range from light and salty Chablis grown in the north, rich and textured whites from the Côte de Beaune around Meursault, and approachable round wines from the Mâcon. There's truly a bottle for everyone – even the “Anything but Chardonnay!” drinkers.

0206 Joseph Drouhin *Drouhin-Vaudon* Chablis 2022

62

Sourced from vineyards all over Chablis, the Drouhin-Vaudon Chablis is a pure snapshot of the region. Classic and lean with seaspray saltiness, you can't beat a bottle of this with our oysters.

0211 Dominique Lafon *Bourgogne Blanc* 2022

136

Dominique Lafon, of the famed Meursault estate Domaine de Comtes Lafon, bottles some of the most classic and elegant styles of Chardonnay in the region's upper slopes under his own label. This wine is restrained and mineral driven given the higher elevations and cooler microclimates, and a great value to try a bottle from such an esteemed winemaker.

0244 Olivier Leflaive *Champlots* Saint Aubin 1er Cru 2021

Saint-Aubin is located in the heart of the Côte des Beaune in Burgundy's Côte d'Or, right between Chassagne-Montrachet and Puligny-Montrachet and southwest of Meursault. Olivier Leflaive's *Champlots* bottling is sleek and flinty with just enough richness to please everyone at the table.

Home to the longest river in France, the Loire Valley is one of the most exciting wine regions in Europe. On the Atlantic Coast, the grape Melon de Bourgogne is used to make salty whites that are perfect with oysters. Further down the river, Chenin Blanc dominates on clay soils with its honeysuckle florality and tart golden apple fruit. Inland, the Central Loire is home to Sancerre, with its limey freshness and racy acidity it is perfect as an aperitif or with light dishes.

0282 Lauverjat Moulin des Vrillères Sancerre 2023

72

The Lauverjat family has been farming in Sancerre for generations. For many years, the family had a mill on a tiny river called La Belaine that is next to the winery and they used to mill their own wheat; the winery is still known by some as the "Moulin des Vrillères". This vibrant Loire Sauvignon Blanc was fermented and aged in stainless steel, preserving its freshness.

0277 Domaine du Nozay Sancerre 2022

95

One of the most respected domaines in the Loire Valley of France also happens to be one of the most sustainable. Domaine du Nozay has been certified Organic since 2011 and Biodynamic since 2017. This is Sauvignon Blanc grown on the famous clay- limestone of the region. Mineral-driven and refreshing, it has a distinct saltiness that separates it from the rest.

0285 Brendan Stater West Brézé Saumur 2020

149

One of the most exciting producers in the Loire Valley is an American expat. Brendan Stater West moved to France to teach English but fell in love with wine while living in Paris. He was able to convince Romain Guiberteau of Chenin Blanc fame to train under him, and the rest is history. This bottling of 100% Chenin Blanc is a touch round with golden apples and perfectly developed due to a few years of bottle age, yet it still maintains the focused acidity that the region is famous for.

With a winemaking history that dates back 2,000 years and home to the world's most famous vineyards, Burgundy serves as a benchmark for style for its native grape, Pinot Noir. Located in pastoral France, spanning just 30 miles south of Dijon, the Golden Slope, or, *Côte d'Or*, of Burgundy produces the most expensive wines in the world. Structure can be achieved in the northern villages near Gevrey-Chambertin, the village of Volnay exudes elegance, and a straightforward Bourgogne Rouge can be as delicious as any other Pinot Noir on the table.

0474 Moissenet-Bonnard *La Cuvée de l'Oncle Paul* 2022 85

Second generation Emmanuel-Sophie Moissenet-Bonnard took over winemaking from her father at their domaine in the southern part of the Côte d'Or near the village of Pommard. This bottling is made from 50 year old vines and farmed without chemicals or pesticides. A deep and serious expression of Pinot from an entry-level Bourgogne Rouge – not to be missed!

0415 Domaine Regnaudot *La Fussière* 1er Cru 2022 112

A small family domaine tucked away in the southwest corner of the Côte d'Or, plantings from this single vineyard in Maranges date back to 1930. This bottling from Domaine Regnaudot is fresh, elegant, and so easy to drink.

0451 Jacques-Frédéric Mugnier *Clos de la Maréchale* 1er Cru 2011 440

One of the most prized holdings for the Mugnier family, Clos de la Maréchale is an enclosed single vineyard known for producing some of the most elegant fruit in Nuits-Saint-Georges. This is a chance to drink a sip of Burgundy history from a vintage that has recently turned around.

0428 Armand Rousseau *Lavaux St. Jacques* 1er Cru 2021 750

Armand Rousseau is a legendary producer with some of the top vineyard holdings in Gevrey-Chambertin. This Premier Cru bottling from Lavaux St. Jacques is powerful and structured while still maintaining finesse.

Situated on the mid-Atlantic coast of France around the Gironde river, Bordeaux is home to some of the most legendary wines on earth. In general, wines from the famed Left Bank are Cabernet Sauvignon driven and show power, structure, bolder tannins and dark fruit. Wines from the Right Bank are typically lusher and softer thanks to the higher percentage of Merlot in the blends.

0540 Château Moulin Pey-Labrie Canon-Fronsac 2016 120

Merlot shines with a touch of Malbec grown in the clay and limestone soils of Canon-Fronsac – a region on the Right Bank where you can still find a great value, such as this deep fruited and supple bottle that is comparable wines to St. Émilion. Dark fruited with very soft tannins and slight development from a bit of bottle aging, this is a crowded-pleasing wine!

0506 Château Cantenac Brown Margaux 2019 200

Château Cantenac-Brown is a Third Growth estate in the commune of Margaux, one of the iconic regions on the Left Bank. The beautiful estate is well over 40 hectares planted mostly to Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. This bottle is a classic example of a fine Margaux: fragrant, perfumed yet balanced and elegant on the palate.

0520 Château Lynch Bages Pauillac 2010 600

A true insider's wine, the classified growth has been around since the 17th Century but has become a darling within the wine community. Lynch Bages is a Cabernet Sauvignon dominant blend that's softened with the addition of Merlot and Cabernet Franc. It's powerful, long lived, and showing great from the soon-to-be legendary 2010 vintage.

Jean-Louis Chave is the best syrah winemaker in the world – full stop. His family has been growing grapes and farming land in the Northern Rhône since the 1400s. While his domaine produces some of the most expensive examples of the grape, his newer project of JL Chave Selection brings his winemaking to an everyday level. This wine from St. Joseph, opposite the hill of Hermitage, is powerful and shows blackberries and meatiness.

0609 Domaine De Durban Gigondas 2022

From the rolling hills of the Southern Rhône, De Durban's Gigondas is densely concentrated and deeply opaque. A majority of Grenache and a generous dose of Syrah result in a distinctly smoky and sculpted wine with structured tannins, and a whiff of violet. An incredibly versatile wine!

0570 Domaine de Vieux Télégraphe *Télégramme*

The famed Brunier family of Châutuneuf-du-Pape has been crafting some of the most iconic and delicious wines of the region for over 100 years. Télégramme is made from younger vines around the winery's prized sites, expressing the nobility of carefully farmed Grenache from the Rhône's finest terroirs. It's plush and elegant with ripe red fruit and enough backbone to stand up to all dishes.

Romain Guiberteau is the fourth generation winemaker of Domaine Guiberteau and owns some of the best land in the Loire Valley. He was failing as a law student when he decided to take over the management of his family's vineyards. Le Moulins is 100% Cabernet Franc in an elegant and lifted style that shows bright red cherries with a touch of green herbs.

0655 Domaine de la Grand'Cour *Clos de la Gran'Cour* Fleurie 2022 115

The single vineyard Clos de la Grand Cour exemplifies the commune of Fleurie with lovely florals and tart red fruit. All the Dutraive wines are farmed organically, made with native yeast fermentations, and see no sulfur.

0653 Alex Foillard Brouilly Beaujolais, France 2020 96

Beginning at just 24 years old, Alex Foillard took a page from his famous winemaker father's book and garnered a finesse for working organically and naturally. The vines here are all 50 years in age planted in granite soils. A floral, deep, and concentrated wine from one of Beaujolais's rising stars.

0644 Domaine du Gros 'Noré Bandol 2018 150

Gros 'Noré Bandol truly is the definition of Provence in a bottle. The Mourvedre based blend is dark and meaty with dried herbs and rugged earthiness ensuring it sings at the table with southern French ingredients. This wine is full-flavored and full-throttle, loaded with warmth, joviality, and down-home familiarity.

Co-owners Mikey Giugni and Michael Brughelli first met in college at Cal Poly before both pursued careers in winemaking. They now focus on small vineyard holdings in cool climates in the Central Coast. This Santa Barbara Pinot Noir is light with candied cherry, juicy cranberry, and earl grey tea.

0712 Las Jaras *Glou Glou* 2022 65

Named after a cheeky French term for highly-drinkable wines, Glou Glou (*glug glug!*) is the perfect red for a crowd. This is a blend of Zinfandel, Carignan, Valdigué and Sangiovese grown in Mendocino, Northern California. Most of the grapes underwent carbonic maceration, the classic fermentation method of the Beaujolais, ensuring a fruity and fresh red that won't last long around the table.

0722 Frog's Leap Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley, CA 2020 300

Frog's Leap is an iconic producer in the Rutherford district of Napa Valley crafting wines in the old-school California style. Dry farmed vines, biodiversity, year-round vineyard staff, and a biodynamic farming approach are all reasons this sustainable Cabernet is consistently one of Napa's best.

0810 Fullerton *Summit View* Cabernet Sauvignon 2021 130

Family-owned and operated, Fullerton mainly focuses on Pinot Noirs from the Willamette Valley. Their first foray into Cabernet Sauvignon from Walla Walla had impressed us with its power, structure, and intensity of fruit. A great value for a classic Cabernet aged in 100% new oak barrels!
