- ★ ***Skin Contact/Orange - White wines that have extended skin contact. This imbues the wine with texture and color which is derived from the skins of the grapes. Depending on the length of time that wines are left on the skins the resulting color and texture will vary in intensity.***

# Sommelier Selections

## The Wines Of GAJA

~ The GAJA Family can trace their roots in Barbaresco back to the 17th Century. Five Generations of this notable family and their commitment to uncompromising quality has made them one of the most famous names in the world of wine.

~ Angelo GAJA is most well known for bringing much deserved attention to Barbaresco as a region capable of producing fine wines. He personally traveled to places such as New York to showcase the GAJA wines at a time when Italian wine was generally considered inexpensive and easy. Some may be familiar with the oceans of cheap Chianti that flooded the market. Those wines were sold in jugs with a traditional straw basket covering known as a fiasco.

~ GAJA was the first to produce single vineyard wines in Barbaresco. Their commitment to the land and their community is exceptional. Over time the GAJA family has invested themselves in other fine wine growing regions in Italy such as Barolo, Bolgheri, Montalcino and their most recent project in Sicily.

- 70.0965\* ▲ **GAJA, Sauvignon Blanc, Alteni di Brassica, Langhe, IT 2021.....\$345**  
~ Sauvignon Blanc is not often considered when speaking of wines which can truly showcase terroir. This white wine perfectly displays a side of Barbaresco and Serralunga typically only expressed through Nebbiolo. Total vineyards size is roughly 7.5 acres. Soils are primarily calcareous clay.  
~ Winemaker Notes: The 2021 vintage of Alteni di Brassica is a classic style of Sauvignon Blanc from Langhe with notes of oyster shell, mountain herbs, white peach, and flint. With time in the glass, it opens to reveal more vibrant notes of sage, cedar, tomato leaf, and cardamom. The mouthfeel is fresh, long, and savoury with a medium-bodied style that ends with a hint of salinity.
- \*41.3610\* ▲ **Ca' Marcanda, Promis, Tuscany, IT 2021.....Coravin Glass 5oz pour \$45, Bottle \$150**  
~ Ca' Marcanda is born of Angelo GAJA's desire to experiment with classic Bordeaux grape varieties. He was also inspired by the Super Tuscan movement. This is a blend of Merlot, Syrah and Sangiovese.  
~ Winemaker Tasting Notes: Coming from a classic, Bolgheri vintage, Promis shows a bright, ruby-red color. The nose has hints of spice such as cinnamon and star anise along with pronounced red fruits like strawberry and black cherry. The tannins are juicy and persistent all culminating in a salinity that is a classic hallmark of good vintages in Bolgheri.
- 20.2302 ▲ **Pieve Santa Restituta, Brunello di Montalcino, IT 2019.....Coravin Glass 5oz pour \$80, Bottle \$265**  
~ Winemaker Tasting Notes: The nose exhibits complex floral and flowery notes, leaning towards sweet, ripe fruit such as Morello cherry and plum, adorned with chocolate nuances and sandalwood. Charming, soft tannins create a long and pleasant mouthfeel. The structure is full, with well-balanced acidity and tannins, culminating in a finish highlighted by savory, salty licorice.
- \*20.2155 ▲ **GAJA, Sperss, Barolo, IT 2019.....\$1,085**  
~ Winemaker Notes: The deep and mineral notes typical of the Serralunga terroir combine with the excellent fruity elements: sour black cherry, goudron, truffle, rhubarb and liquorice. The mouthfeel reveals an austere texture and a full body, dense and complex.
- \*20.2250 ▲ **GAJA, Sorì San Lorenzo, Barbaresco, IT 2020.....\$1,800**  
~ Winemaker Notes: Sweet notes on the nose with a beautiful structure of fruit tannins with a lovely, intense color. It is closed initially but when it opens, it has a striking, multifaceted, dense texture. The cask aging also gives the wine a great edge, a little more verve, and tension with notes of salinity, citrus, cassis, currants, mustard, smokiness, and licorice. A deeply complex wine.

*Mary's passion for wine began in 2014 working in some of the top restaurants in Maui, HI. She developed a flair for matching guests with wine and food. An established ethos when curating wine quickly became important in her growth. Wine producers who are farming sustainably, organically and biodynamically are the theme of many of the wines on the list.*

*At the core of Nick's passion for wine is its connection to people. He believes that when we're drinking it, we're connecting to the people we're with, as well as the people that took the care to produce it. Furthermore, he places emphasis on knowing more about who made it, how they made it and where it is from so you will be guided to a greater understanding of what's in your glass. Nick doesn't claim to specialize in any particular region, but gravitates towards more "cerebral" wines. He gets excited about taking calculated risks with food pairings and believes there's value in every wine on our list.*

*Koryne devoted her career to hospitality after discerning the divine harmony it offers between her love for storytelling and the magic of a crowded table.  ~ Gloria Ferrer is the first winery in Napa to produce sparkling wine in Carneros. Founded in 1982 by José and Gloria Ferrer. The first 50 acres was planted by 1984 and two years later they opened their doors. Gloria Ferrer Winery is committed to sustainability through biodiversity, soil health, water management, integrated pest management, energy conservation and green business.  
 ~ The 2014 Royal Cuveé is a blend of 67% Pinot Noir and 33% Chardonnay. This Cuveé was first served to the King and Queen of Spain in 1987. Layers of fruit, apple pie, pears, toasty brioche and brûléed mandarin orange. A delightful and richly textured traditional method sparkling wine.

 ~ Delicately effervescent this sparkling rosé tantalizes with notes of wild strawberry, citrus orchard and blossoms. Finishes dry with an enticing mineral and phenolic grip.

~ This property was established in 1980 and originally owned and operated by Manuel Otero y Otero. Señor Otero y Otero was a fine foods entrepreneur specifically of conserves which are tinned food delicacies.

~ The property is located in the coolest of the five sub zones of Rias Baixas known as Val do Salnes. Average year round temperature is 55°F. Farming practices are traditional.

~ Albariño is a wine that is known to please both Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Grigio lovers alike. Expect both citrus and orchard fruit notes intertwined with a crushed rock minerality.
