Sommelier Selections

Jean Foillard is one of those names in the world of wine that is legendary in the region of Beaujolais, France. These wines are highly sought after and many restaurants only receive only a small allocation every year. Gamay is the dominant grape variety here. Genetically related to Pinot Noir it has many similarities.

~

Jean and Agnes Foillard, pronounced: fwah-yar, inherited the family vineyards from Jean Foillard's father in 1980. Jean Foillard and three other vigneron at this time became disciples of Jules Chauvet. This group of vigneron were dubbed, Kermit Lynch's (a wine importer) Gang of Four, they are Jean Foillard, Marcel Lapierre, Jean-Paul Thévenet, and Guy Breton. Jules Chauvet advocated for the old ways of farming and making wine. No synthetic pesticides or chemical fertilizers. Limited use of sulphur dioxide or none at all. Picking grapes at optimal ripeness, hand sorting so that only the most optimal fruit is fermented.

Beaujolais has gained attention for its fruity and playful wines that it produces with notes of Bubblegum and Banana. Jean Foillard's wines are on a whole different playing field. These wines hail from the most famous villages in Beaujolais, Morgon and Fleurie. The wines are sauvage and spicy with a minerality that speaks to the granite soils found here. Wines are complex and structured and Jean Foillard's signature silky texture makes them extremely quaffable. Perfect with a light chill on them these wines are a great option for those craving a red wine during these warmer months.

~ There are ten Cru Villages in Beaujolais and Fleurie is often touted as being known for its signature aromas of violet and red fruit notes. This particular cuvée has a way of evoking notes of petrichor and pine forest as well.
- *II.1993 ▲ Jean Foillard, Côte du Py, Morgon, FR 2022.....\$145**
~ The Côte du Py (pronounced: coat-duh-pee) is the pride of Morgon. Vineyards of Côte du Py sit on an alluvial fan of schist and granite at the highest point above the town. Powerful, structured with notes of red berries and forest floor.
- II.1995 ▲ Jean Foillard, Cuveé Corcelette, Morgon, FR 2022.....\$145**
~ Fruit is harvested from 80 year old vines. Rose petals, skipping stones and red fruits entrance the senses. Like all Jean Foillard's wines it finishes with a deep structured minerality and Foillard's signature silky texture.

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KEY

- **Biodynamic** - Biodynamic wines are Demeter certified or following the principles of Biodynamic farming. Essentially, this particular way of farming is an organic and holistic approach to understanding the vine from soil health to preserving the land for future generations.
- ▲ **Organic** - Made with organically grown fruit. Grape Growers are organic farming certified or practicing the principles of organic farming.
- **Natural** - The natural wine we choose for our wine list follows four essential rules: made with organic grapes; minimal intervention from the winemaker; indigenous yeast fermentations; minimal SO₂ treatments.
- ★ **Skin Contact/Orange** - White wines that have extended skin contact. This imbues the wine with texture and color which is derived from the skins of the grapes. Depending on the length of time that wines are left on the skins the resulting color and texture will vary in intensity.

 ~ Established in 1811 by Pierre-Nicolas Perrier and Rose-Adélaïde Jouët. They were both advocates for the arts. Pierre-Nicolas was a vintner and botanist and Rose Adelaïde was from a Norman merchant family.
 ~ 1842 is when the iconic floral design was first created linking Perrier-Jouët to the Art Nouveau movement. Today the historic home of Perrier Jouët is a museum dedicated to the Art Nouveau movement of the late 19th century.
 ~ The Grand Brut is a blend of Chardonnay from the Côte de Blancs, Pinot Noir from the Montagne de Reims and Meunier from the Vallée de la Marne. A versatile Champagne with notes of orchard fruit and subtle hints of tropical citrus. Delicately floral with notes of roasted nuts. The finish is generous and balanced.

~ Gloria Ferrer is the first winery in Napa to produce sparkling wine in Carneros. Founded in 1982 by José and Gloria Ferrer. The first 50 acres was planted by 1984 and two years later they opened their doors. Gloria Ferrer Winery is committed to sustainability through biodiversity, soil health, water management, integrated pest management, energy conservation and green business.
~ The 2014 Royal Cuveé is a blend of 67% Pinot Noir and 33% Chardonnay. This Cuveé was first served to the King and Queen of Spain in 1987. Layers of fruit, apple pie, pears, toasty brioche and brûléed mandarin orange. A delightful and richly textured traditional method sparkling wine.

 ~ Ruinart has been commercially producing Champagne since 1729 and is the oldest established Champagne House. Stylistically these wines have a lovely richness to them. The blend is made up of 45% Chardonnay all sourced from the Côte des Blancs and Pinot Noir from Montagne de Reims and Vallée de la Marne, 43% vinified as a white wine and 12% vinified as a red wine.
 ~ This Rosé has a refined structured, soft roundness and is refreshingly complex. Rose and exotic tropical fruits are the first impression. As the wine opens soft spice notes slowly reveal themselves.

~ Established in 1971 by Josh Jensen, Calera, is inspired by Josh Jensen's mentors in Burgundy who were very passionate about chardonnay being grown in limestone. Josh Jensen was determined to find a vineyard location in California with limestone soils and Calera was born.

~Winemaker Notes: Grown high on the limestone-rich soils of Mt. Harlan, this wine is an aromatic beauty, revealing layers of white peach, fresh-cut grass, lavender and lemon verbena. Though rich and round on the palate, its cool-climate origins ensure a lively underlying acidity that provides focus and finesse to tropical flavors of guava, pineapple and vanilla bean.

Chardonnay - Chablis

*61.0620 **Domaine Laroche, Chablis Grand Cru Les Clos, FR 2022.....\$450**

~ Chablis is the northernmost region of the esteemed and world renowned region of Burgundy. The vineyards are planted on Kimmeridgian soils, an ancient bed of fossilized oyster shells, which are said to imbue these wines with their crushed oyster shell minerality and ocean breeze finish.

~ There is a single Grand Cru in Chablis which is divided into seven climats. Blanchot, Bougros, Les Clos, Grenouilles, Preuses, Valmur, and Vaudésir. Les Clos is often considered to be the most prized of the climats.

~ Domaine Laroche was established in 1850. They cellar and age their wine in the L'Obédiencerie, a former monastery in the village of Chablis.

~ This wine is a great option for lovers of Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay. Lime blossom and citrus fruits envelope the senses. Aromas of flint, linden flowers and tart pomme fruits round out the dry mineral driven finish.

Chardonnay - Mâconnais

~ *Domaine Leflaive* was established in the early 1700s. Claude Leflaive made his home in the village of Puligny-Montrachet known for the wines it produces from the Grand Cru Montrachet.

~ In the early 1990s Anne-Claude Leflaive, 4th generation, started to experiment with biodynamic farming. She started with a plot that was to be pulled out and replanted as the vines had succumbed to fan leaf virus. Her efforts were rewarded and today *Domaine Leflaive* is one of the leading producers in biodynamics.

~ Notes of citrus and orchard fruits interplay with crushed rocks. Balanced with hints of spice and toast on the elegant finish.
